GENERAL INFORMATION

- ◆ This information provides a guide to the process and forms necessary to convert a Legal Separation to a Dissolution of Civil Union.
- ◆ Your motion should be filed in the District Court where the Decree for Legal Separation was issued.
- You must wait a minimum of 182 days from the date of the Decree of Legal Separation before you can file your motion to convert – JDF 1259.

FEES

A \$105.00 filing fee is required. If you are unable to pay, you must complete the Motion to File without Payment and Supporting Financial Affidavit (JDF 205) and submit it to the Court. Once you submit the completed JDF 205 form and a blank Order (JDF 206), the Court will decide if you need to pay the filing fee.
